FREE COMMUNITY SCREENINGS FOR RESIDENTS, LOCAL CHARITIES AND CHARITABLE GROUPS

We continued to organise resident and charity screenings in 2025. Supporting local resident associations, charities and charitable groups, we showed *'Thunderbolts'* – *'Aladdin'* – *'Mission Impossible: The Final Reckoning'* - *'Paddington in Peru'* – *'The Grinch'* – *'Goldeneye'* – *'The Goonies'* – *'Muppets Christmas Carol'* - *'The Great Escaper'* - *'Wonka'* – *'How To Train Your Dragon'* – *'Ghostbusters'* – *'101 Dalmatians'* – *'Minecraft Movie'* – *'Chitty Chitty Bang Bang'* – *'Beetlejuice Beetlejuice'*.

Many of the screenings were organised to help raise funds for local groups and schools like the Ivers Good Neighbour Scheme, 1st Iver Heath Brownies, Iver Heath Infant School, Iver Heath Junior School, The Bridgettine Convent, Iver Heath and Iver Village Residents Association. We look forward to arranging more screenings to support our community in 2026.



OUTDOOR SCREENINGS FOR RESIDENTS – INDOORS!

Due to inclement weather, our annual outdoor screenings were hosted in one of our stages this year.

We held two screenings in the stage, the first being '*Goldeneye*' in its 30th anniversary year. The second was '*The Goonies*', celebrating 40 years since its release.

Over 600 local residents attended both screenings and enjoyed the opportunity to step inside one of our famous stages.





SUPPORTING LOCAL SCHOOLS AND THE NFTS IN BUCKINGHAMSHIRE

We continue to support local schools and colleges in several ways. We have provided parent and teacher associations with raffle prizes, provided shuttle buses for school trips and offered visits to Buckinghamshire New University. We have also provided surplus stationery/office supplies to help bolster school resources as we have done in previous years.

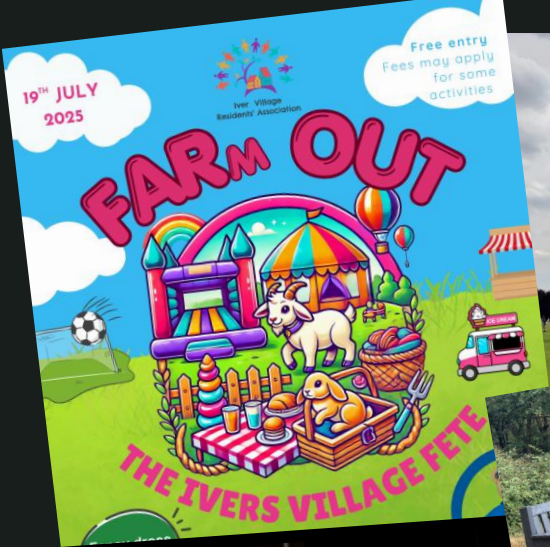

OPENING UP OUR DOORS TO FUTURE FILMMAKERS: FUTURES FESTIVAL 2026

Futures Festival 2026 took place at Pinewood Studios on Friday 30 January and Saturday 31 January. It is Europe's largest free careers event for those looking to start a career in the Film & TV industry.

This year close to 4,500 young people and career changers from across the UK visited the Studios. The experience took place in multiple dedicated areas across the Studios including The John Barry Theatre, RA-Stage, Z-Stage, 007 Stage and tenant spaces.

Many schools and colleges from across Buckinghamshire attended the event after being given priority access to tickets.

FUTURES FESTIVAL

Speaker sessions hosted by Radio One Film Critic and Journalist Ali Plumb in our John Barry Theatre, featured an eclectic mix of talks, panel interviews and Q&As.

We hosted experiences in our Post-Production Theatre with a live sound mix demonstration. Iver Make Up Academy demonstrated hair and make-up in a state-of-the-art Translux Makeup Trailer, whilst Creative Media Skills Institute shot on a video wall within their new workshop space onsite. Sony provided an interactive live shoot demo, showcasing the different roles on set and allowing the students to experience those roles. For the first time this year, we saw a live action stunt demonstration in our world famous 007 stage.

We thoroughly enjoyed seeing the young people being fully engaged and excited about the range of careers available in the industry.
